Minute ARMC 17-18/48: CONSIDERATION/ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 5TH MEETING OF THE AUDIT AND RISK MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL HELD ON 12TH MAY, 2018

The Minutes of the 5th Meeting of the Committee held on Saturday, 12th May, 2018 were adopted as the correct record of proceedings at the meeting on a motion by Mr. Tola Adeyemi and seconded by Pastor Bayo Olugbemi after the following corrections:

a. <u>Page 2, Line 58</u>: "....(ACEGID) uploaded on the University website" to read "
....(ACEGID) **had been** uploaded on the University website".

b. Page 3, Line 107 – 110: "The Acting Bursar said that the Committee of Vice-Chancellors and Registrars of Private Universities (CVCRPU).....all private Universities" to read "The Acting Bursar said that it was a general problem with all private Universities and the Committee of Vice-Chancellors and Registrars of Private Universities was looking into it on behalf of all private Universities"

c. <u>Page 5, Line 190</u>: "consolidate 2015 ACEGID ...into **2016** accounts...." to read "consolidate 2015 ACEGID ...into **2015** accounts......"

d. <u>Page 5, Line 210</u>: "that the University had never met a set deadline for it and this was another case of not meeting the Committees deadlines "to read" that the Acting Bursar had never met a set deadline and this was another case of not meeting the Committee's deadlines mutually agreed upon".

e. Page 7, Line 260: "...should not be a criteria" to read "..should not be a criterion"

f. Page 10,Line 386: "The Committee decided that there was no need to readvertise for External auditor by the University" to read ". The Committee decided that there was no need to re-advertise for External Auditors by the University. The earlier submissions should be re-appraised.

i. Minute ARMC 17-18/39(i): Re: Consideration of Accounts

Training on Management of Grants

The Committee noted its advice at its 4th Meeting that the Ag. Bursar should liaise with Mr. Tola Adeyemi for necessary guidance/modalities for organising the training on grants for Bursary staff. It further noted that the Ag. Bursar had not contacted Mr. Tola Adeyemi on the matter.

Mr. S.A Momodu said that he had discussed with Mr. Tola Adeyemi and informed him that the Bursar would take further necessary action on the matter.

The Registry was requested to ensure a proper follow-up on Department or Unit that was suppose to act or provide the Committee with necessary information and present same to the Committee at its next meeting.

The Committee noted that no action had been taken on the provision of official document on the offer of scholarship to some students by the University for programmes in ACEGID.

The Committee also noted that the annexure to the ACEGID documents had been provided and sighted by the External Auditors.

iii. Minute ARMC 17-18/39 (iii): Re: Update on Redeemer's University 2015 and 2016 Accounts

The Committee noted its decision that any document for its consideration should be forwarded to members at least two (2) weeks before meetings with a follow-up text

message drawing the attention of members to the sent documents.

The Committee also noted that the issue of the Legal Status of the University was being looked into by the Committee of Vice-Chancellors of Private Universities (CVCRPU) and

following fresh information provided by the Vice-Chancellor on phone, it was suggested that the matter could be approached from different angles.

The Chairperson stated that she had discussed with the Vice-Chancellor that Ernst & Young would accept a fee of **Seven Million**, **Five Hundred Thousand Naira** (**N7,500,000.00**) **only**. The Committee also decided that if Ernst & Young would also audit ACEGID Account along with that of the University for the same amount as fee, the offer would be a very good one. The Committee therefore promised to further discuss the matter with representatives of E&Y.

Minute ARMC 17-18/50: EXTRACTS FROM THE DECISION OF COUNCIL ON THE REPORT FROM THE 5TH MEETING OF THE AUDIT AND RISK MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The Audit Committee noted the decisions of the Governing Council of the Redeemer's University at its 51st Statutory Meeting held on Thursday, 8th June, 2018 on the Committee's recommendations from its 5th Meeting held on Saturday, 12th May, 2018.

Minute ARMC 17-18/51: <u>AFRICAN CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE FOR GENOMICS</u> <u>OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES (ACEGID) ACCOUNTS</u>

a) Audited Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31st December, 2017

The Committee received and considered the ACEGID, Redeemer's University Audited Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31st December, 2017 The Committee was informed that it had been forwarded for the purpose of meeting the requirement of the National Universities Commission (NUC). During consideration the Committee observed as follows, that:

- 1) it was difficult to align expenditure as indicated with specific grant:
- 2) it was not easy to ascertain if the conditions for the grants were met in relation to expenditure; and
- 3) grants were in Dollars but expenditures were reported in Naira.
 - Consequent upon the above observations, the Committee recommended that:
- 1) the Bursar should provide a fresh analysis of the expenditure using a column to be provided by Mr. Tola Adeyemi;

- 2) grants and the expenditure should be shown in Dollars at a particular exchange rate;
 - 3) the Committee should be provided an overview of all the grants;
 - 4) expenditure for grants should be clearly delineated; and

5) a synopsis of what ACEGID is and set out to do should be provided and ditto for the grants.

b) Management Control Report (MCR) for the Year Ended 31st December, 2017

The Committee received and considered the ACEGID, Management Control Report for the Year Ended 31st December, 2017

Minute ARMC 17-18/52: PROGRESS REPORT FROM THE RUN PRINCIPAL INTERNAL AUDITOR

The Committee received and considered the progress report from the Directorate of University Internal Audit. The Principal Internal Auditor presented the report and after due consideration the Committee recommended as follows:

- a. **Students Accounts (Postgraduate Students)**: All Post-Graduate students should be mandated to make their fee payments via their designated portals within an approved timelines.
 - The Registrar remarked that he would find out from the Vice-Chancellor if the current arrangement of payment without any definite timeline was to attract candidates.
- b. **Internally Generated Revenue (IGR)**: New and a more efficient software application should be purchased to address the observed problem with the current software being used by the electricity metering office. The software should be one that would detect any infraction in the process of payment/recharging, billing and consumption. It also recommended a weekly physical reconciliation of the staff prepaid account by the Bursary department.
- c. Directorate of Educational Services and Training (DEST): The Committee noted the huge debt owed the Directorate by former students and recommended that debtor students should henceforth be denied writing their final JUPEB examinations. Efforts should be made to recover all the debts owed the Directorate.

d. RUN Consult: The Committee recommended that RUN Consult should be restructured to focus on its principal activities of provision of educational and vocational training for individuals and corporate bodies as well as management of financial and accounting consultancies and business support services. It should therefore leave its current business of bakery, laundry etc for a new outfit to be called Redeemer's University Ventures.

RUN Consult and other arms of the University should operate within the general framework of the University extant laws. However, approval of the University Management or Board should be sought on exceptional matters. It further recommended that RUN Consult Board should take full responsibilities of overseeing the activities of the outfit.

Minute ARMC 17-18/53: REDEEMER'S UNIVERSITY CONSOLIDATED AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS 2015 ACCOUNTS AND RUN CONSULT 2016 ACCOUNT

The Committee received the report but could not ratify it because of the issue of the appropriate legal status of the University that was yet to be resolved. However, members were requested to look at the report and forward their comments and observations on or before 20th August, 2018.

On the 2015 University Financial Report and the 2016 RUN Consult Report, it was decided that all documents should be made available to members at least two weeks before the next meeting of the Committee.

Minute ARMC 17-18/54: NEXT MEETING

The next meeting of the Committee was scheduled for Friday, 12th October, 2018, in the University Campus, Ede subject to receiving all expected documents.

Minute ARMC 17-18/55: ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Pastor Ben Akabueze and seconded by Mr. Tola Adeyemi.
